CANCELLATIONS

If more than 24 hours notice of cancellation of a private lesson is given, an alternative time may be arranged (within the same week) If less than 24 notice is given, or if an alternative time cannot be arranged in advance, the fee for that missed lesson is forfeited.

(Please note that if you have made an arrangement to pay for lessons weekly, this cancellation policy applies, and you will be charged for lessons missed without 24 hours notice.)

In the event of a teacher needing to cancel, an alternative time, substitute teacher or refund will be offered.

DISCONTINUING
